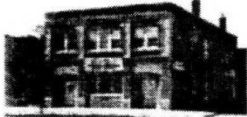
MASS BOOK 2018

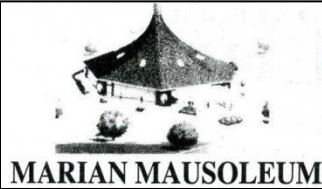
