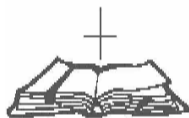

Today's Gospel gives us great joy as we hear of the Resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ. But for Mary of Magdala, Peter and John, there was, at least initially, great sadness because they did not find Jesus where he was supposed to be...in the tomb. They did not yet understand that he had to rise from the dead. More than two millennia later, we too do not always find Jesus where we expect him to be. Instead, Jesus comes to us, sometimes in unexpected ways, even as he did for Mary of Magdala, Peter, John and the other disciples. For now, keep seeking Jesus and trust that, even if we do not find Him where we expect to, He will always find us. Have a Blessed Easter.
