Catholic Cemetery Moment

The First Sunday in November has traditionally been designated as "Cemetery Sunday". This special day reminds all of us of the importance of continued prayer for our beloved dead and to also remember those faithful departed who may have no one to pray for them. They can best be remembered by visiting a Catholic Cemetery, one of our most sacred places.

Faith Moment Reflection

We see a direct correlation between the first reading and the Gospel today. In the Gospel, Jesus is tested by a scribe who asks, "What is the first of all the commandments?" Jesus answers with the same words we hear in Deuteronomy – *love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength.* Then Jesus adds, "The second is this – *You shall love your neighbor as yourself.*" Again, God gives us the directive to love – to love God and to love like God, imitating His ever-present love as a child might imitate a devoted parent. The scribe is impressed with Jesus and understands that loving God and one another is more important than rituals and offerings. To love is to care, to help, to lift up. Love in action is the very purpose of our lives.

Catholic Charities can help. Our Kids: Parent Education and Awareness Program (OKPEAP) is a New York State Certified program available to parents and their significant others who have experienced conflict regarding custody and/or access issues related to their children. This group helps parents develop a "business" relationship that encourages co-parents to refrain from putting children in the middle of arguments. Topics covered include: the impact of separation/divorce on children; cooperative and parallel approaches to co-parenting; legal issues related to custody and/or access; alternatives to litigation; methods of communication and problem-solving. OKPEAP is available at multiple sites throughout Western New York and referrals for this program can be made by anyone, including individuals. For more information, visit www.ccnny.org/okpeap.
