BAPTISM: Please call the parish office to make arrangements.

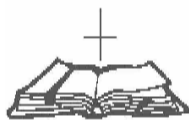

In today's Gospel we learn how faith can help us overcome our fears and doubts. After His resurrection, Jesus came to his disciples, appearing through locked doors and saying repeatedly "Peace be with you." As He spoke, He led them from fear to joy; from doubt to belief. However, Thomas, who was not with them, said he would not believe unless he saw the nail marks in the hands of Jesus for himself. 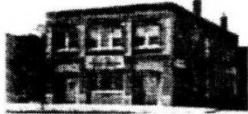

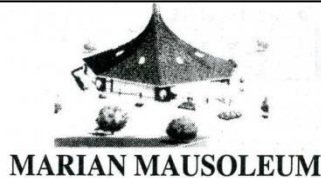
