BAPTISM: Please call the parish office to make arrangements.

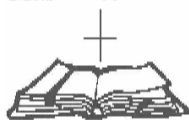

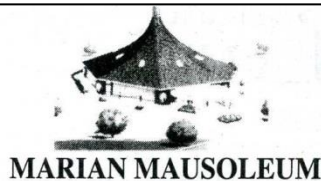
